The petitioner in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.01 dated 03.01.2020 under Sections 21, 22 and 25 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Hathoor, District Ludhiana.

On 24.07.2020 the following order was passed:-

“Inter alia contends that father of the petitioner was arrested at the spot while riding a motorcycle and recovery of the contraband was from his person. He has been nominated as an accused on that account since the motorcycle was registered in his name. It is, thus, submitted that as per Annexures P-3 & P-4, his father had control over the vehicle as the same is sold to him.

Notice of motion for 29.09.2020.

State Counsel accepts notice.

In the meantime, it is directed that the petitioner shall join investigation and in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on ad-interim bail by the investigating officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when required and shall

comply with the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Counsel for the State, on instructions received from ASI Bahadur Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further interrogation.

Accordingly, in view of the above the order dated 24.07.2020 is confirmed and the petition stands disposed of.
