The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 4.3.2020 vide which a direction was issued to respondents No.1 and 2 to consider and decide the application so received within a period of four weeks thereafter and grant pension, if the petitioner is found eligible.

Mr. Satya Pal Jain, Addl. Solicitor General of India with Mr.Alok Kumar Jain, Advocate has pointed out that the order has been duly complied with. The matter was considered and the case of the petitioner was rejected vide speaking order dated 19.8.2020. A copy of the order has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the same, the contempt petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed accordingly.

Rule issued against the respondent(s) is discharged.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to challenge the said order dated 19.8.2020 in accordance with law, if so advised.
