Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the order dated 20.01.2020 passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Special Leave to Appeal (Crl.) No.1411/2018*** titled as ***Harmanpreet Kaur alias Bani Versus Harbhajan Singh***, the present petition is rendered infructuous. He has produced the copy of the aforesaid order, which is taken on record.

This fact has not been disputed by learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3.

The aforementioned order dated 20.01.2020 passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Special Leave to Appeal (Crl.) No.1411/2018*** reads as under:

“Learned counsel for both the sides submit that the parties have compromised inter se and have filed a settlement memo to the said effect. The settlement memo dated 20.01.2020 is duly

signed by both the learned counsel. It is also signed by Mr. Jagdev Singh, uncle of the petitioner and Mr. Simran Virsingh son of the respondent. Both of them agreed that they have got instructions to get the matter settled. The settlement memo is taken on record and the contents therein are recorded. The settlement memo discloses the list of pending cases between the petitioner and the respondent. Since the parties have amicably settled inter se, all the cases which are shown in the settlement memo shall be disposed of as being compromised. The parties are at liberty to file memo to the said effect to the concerned court to get the matters disposed of formally.

The special leave petition is, accordingly, Disposed of.

Pending application, if any, stand disposed of accordingly.”

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as infructuous.

Since the main petition has been dismissed as infructuous, the application i.e. **CRMK-21942 of 2019** is also dismissed as infructuous.
