The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic COVID-19 situation and as per instructions.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a direction to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to decide representation dated 31.05.2020 (Annexure P-7).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Moga, to consider and decide the representation dated 31.05.2020 (Annexure P-7).

Heard.

Having regard to the prayer made and without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Moga, to consider and decide the

representation dated 31.05.2020 (Annexure P-7) expeditiously, preferably, within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter, in accordance with law. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
