The petitioners have filed this writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing of an order dated 20.02.2020, passed by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-Chairman, Appellate Tribunal, Karnal.

At the outset, learned counsel representing respondent No.4 on being confronted with the order passed by the appellant tribunal, has admitted that the Appellate Tribunal has failed to give reasons while analyzing the contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioners herein (the respondents before the Appellate Tribunal). Hence, he conceded that the order passed by the Appellate Tribunal, is required to be set aside with liberty to the Tribunal to pass a fresh order after hearing the parties or their

counsels and examining the case file.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, with the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the order dated 20.02.2020 is set aside. The Appellate Tribunal is requested to pass a fresh speaking order after hearing the parties or their counsels.

The parties, through their counsels, are directed to appear before the Appellate Tribunal on 01.10.2020. The Appellate Tribunal is requested to take a final decision within one month from the date of appearance of the parties.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are disposed of, in view of the above stated order.
