Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner has filed the present criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Respondent no.4 and 5 are the son and daughter-in-law of the petitioner. There appears to be some dispute *inter-se* between the family members. Now the petitioner alleges that she is being harassed and attacked by her family members.

In the considered view of this court, the petitioner has more than one equally efficacious remedy including filing of a criminal complaint as well as a suit for injunction.

In view thereof, the petitioner is relegated to the alternative remedy.

Disposed of accordingly.
