The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.57 dated 02.04.2019 registered under Sections 323/452/34 IPC at Police Station Canal Colony, District Bathinda.

It is contended by counsel for the petitioners that the case against the petitioners is totally concocted. Even as per the allegations of the prosecution, the petitioners are alleged to be not having any weapon as such. The petitioner No.1 is of 69 years of age. Otherwise also, the alleged injuries upon the complainant are stated to be simple in nature.

Notice of motion.

Mr. V.G. Jauhar, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned State Counsel, being instructed by ASI Sukhram, has submitted that the petitioners have specifically been named in the case. However, it is not disputed that the injuries suffered by the complainant are simple in nature and that no specified weapon, as such, has been used in the incident.

In view of the above submissions, but without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioners are granted concession of anticipatory bail. Therefore, it is directed that in case of their arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/ Investigating Officer. However, it is further directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
