Present petition has been filed by the petitioner, namely, Kuldeep @ Vicky, under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 39, dated 22.02.2020, registered under Section 379 IPC and Section 136 of the Indian Electricity Act, 2003, at Police Station Sadar Kaithal, District Kaithal.

Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing due to spread of novel corona virus and consequent restricted functioning of the Courts.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in various FIRs registered in the same police station in the same month. He has further draws attention of the court to an order passed in CRM-M-17643-2020 (Kuldeep @ Vicky vs. State of Haryana), on 22.07.2020 in FIR No.33 dated 18.02.2020. He further submits that the petitioner is in custody since 12.03.2020.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has opposed the

prayer on the ground that the petitioner is involved in other criminal cases of similar nature.

On conclusion of the investigation, the police report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been filed.

The conclusion of the trial is likely to take time.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the order passed on 22.07.2020, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail, if not required in any other case, subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
