The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.260 dated 27.05.2018, under Sections 365, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Mahendergarh, District Mahendergarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had been initially found innocent and kept in column No.2, however, was summoned on an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. It is submitted that on account of the fact that the petitioner has been summoned as an additional accused, stay of his arrest was prayed for. It is informed that pursuant to the order dated 03.05.2019, the petitioner herein had appeared

before the trial court and has been released on interim bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, does not dispute the fact that order dated 03.05.2019 has been complied.

In view of the facts that pursuant to the order dated 03.05.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the trial court and released on interim bail, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 03.05.2019 is hereby made absolute.
