This is second petition for grant of bail to the petitioner in a criminal case arising from FIR No.28 dated 14.03.2019 registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur.

The first application for grant of bail filed by the petitioner was dismissed on 08.11.2019 alongwith another application of a co-accused.

The order dated 08.11.2019 is extracted as under:-

“By this order, CRM-M-23515 and 26145 of 2019 shall stand disposed of.

Petitioners in both the cases are alleged to be in conscious possession of 25 injections of Bupernorphine 2 ml each.

Learned counsel for the State submits that petitioner

Gurpreet Singh @ Ramu is involved in 2 more criminal cases under the NDPS Act, whereas petitioner Robendeep Singh @ Robit is involved in 5 more criminal cases out of which 2 are under the NDPS Act.

Learned counsel appearing for petitioner-Gurpreet Singh @ Ramu has submitted that he has been acquitted in FIR No.75, dated 03.08.2017.

Be that as it may, in view of large number of cases, this court is not inclined to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioners in both the cases, at this stage.

Dismissed.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to made out a fresh ground for grant of bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
