The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondent No.2 to conduct a fair, impartial and proper investigation in FIR No.398 dated 23.06.2017 under Sections 384 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Surajkund, District Faridabad.

Prayer has also been made for issuance of directions to the respondents to arrest the accused persons, who are threatening the petitioner and his family members to part with money to compromise the false case FIR No.57 dated 10.04.2017 under Section 376 IPC registered at Women Police Station, Sector-16, Faridabad at the instance of one Priya Dixit.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kallu Singh, submits that so far as the FIR No.398 is concerned, after completion of investigation, the police has submitted an untraced report in the case. She further submits that in FIR No.57, there were 4 accused, out of whom, 3 accused were found innocent during the investigation and 1 accused faced trial and acquitted by the trial Court.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition, however, with liberty to file protest petition in FIR No.398 dated 23.06.2017 under Sections 384 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Surajkund, District Faridabad.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
