The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner against the order dated 19.11.2015 (Annexure P-6), whereby the petitioner was declared as a proclaimed person in the proceedings under the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 (for short 'the Act'), initiated by respondent No. 2-Mehar Finance Company, Rampura Phul.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that a compromise has been effected between the petitioner and respondent No.2 (complainant) on 20.05.2020 (Annexure P.10), whereby the entire amount has been paid by the petitioner to respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is ready to appear before the trial Court and as the petitioner has paid back the entire amount to respondent No.2, the trial Court may be directed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Notice in this case is not being issued to respondent No.2, as the same would result in unnecessary delay in the proceedings before the trial Court.

As respondent No.2 is stated to have received the entire amount as recorded in the compromise dated 20.05.2020, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the trial Court on 07.09.2020 and the trial Court after verifying the authenticity and genuineness of the compromise dated 20.05.2020, shall enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner shall pay an amount of Rs.5,000/- as costs to respondent No.2.
