The petitioner in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.280 dated 28.05.2020 under Sections 406, 420, 370, 195-A, 506, 120-B IPC, Sections 10, 24 and 25 of Immigration Act and Section 12 of Passport Act, registered at Police Station Pehowa, District Kurukshetra.

On 24.07.2020, the following order was passed:-

“Inter alia contends that the matter has been settled with respondent No.2-Daljit Singh and he has also submitted his affidavit (Annexure P-2) in this context.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Deepak Bhardwaj, Advocate and Mr. Fateh Saini, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 & 2, respectively.

Counsel for the State prays for time to verify the veracity of Annexure P-2.

List on 30.09.2020.

In the meantime, it is directed that the petitioner shall join investigation and in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on ad-interim bail by the investigating officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when required and shall comply with the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Counsel for the State, on instructions received from SI Rishipal, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation, but further submits that he has not cooperated with the Investigation Officer. However, counsel for the complainant, Mr. Fateh Saini, submits that the matter has been settled inter se and he does not wish to oppose the bail application.

Keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances, since the complainant as such is apparently satisfied, the order dated 24.07.2020 is confirmed. The petition stands disposed off, accordingly.
