The petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the official respondents to produce his wife namely Sanju Rani, who is stated to be illegally confined by respondent No.5.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police (North), Jalandhar on behalf of respondent No.1 to 4, which is taken on record. It is stated in the reply that the alleged detainee is now staying with the petitioner. It is also stated that proceedings have been initiated against respondent No.5 on the complaint of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the wife of the petitioner has returned to their matrimonial house and is residing with the petitioner. He, however, contends that respondent No.5 has been threatening the petitioner.

The grievance of the petitioner with regard to his wife having been illegally detained has been redressed. On the application of the petitioner, action has also been initiated against respondent No.5, therefore, no further directions are called for in this petition which stands disposed of.
