This Civil Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents to release gratuity, grant full pension and notional promotion and all other benefits arising thereafter from 02.11.2010 when his juniors were promoted and further to take action on legal notice dated 22.06.2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already sent legal notice dated 22.06.2020 to respondent No.1-Principal Secretary, Punjab, Department of PWD (B&R) Branch, Mini Secretariat, Sector-9, Chandigarh, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/4, but still no action has been taken.

At the asking of Court, Ms. Simran Grewal, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to her.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.1-Principal Secretary, Punjab, Department of PWD (B&R) Branch, Mini Secretariat, Sector-9, Chandigarh, to look into and decide legal notice dated 22.06.2020 (Annexure P/4) in accordance with law and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
