Vide judgment dated 16.11.2019, annexure P-1, this Court allowed the writ petition of the petitioners and directed the respondents therein to release their pension within a period of three months from the date CPF was deposited by the petitioners. The allegation is that the amount of CPF to be deposited has still not been communicated to the petitioners.

It is not clear as to when the petitioners raised a demand regarding communication of the CPF amount to be deposited. Legal notice on record is dated 16.6.2020, which is quite recent.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that after the legal notice dated 16.6.2020 was sent, a response has been received that directions have been issued to the Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana to comply with the judgment dated 16.11.2019.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of with the observation that in case, the judgment dated 16.11.2019 passed by this Court, is not complied with within a period of three months from today, the petitioners shall be at liberty to file a fresh contempt petition.
