This application has been filed by the petitioners seeking permission to place on record Annexure P-12.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the document (Annexure P-12) is taken on record.

CWP No.10625 of 2020

Petitioners-Mandeep Kaur and four others have filed the present writ petition jointly, *inter alia* with the prayer to direct the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners for regularization of their services.

Record of the case shows that on 27.07.2020, notice of motion

was issued.

Today on the resumed hearing of the case, learned counsel for the petitioners, by making reference to the pleadings in the writ petition, submits that the petitioners are working as Sweepers (Class-IV employees) on part time basis since 2007 onwards. Learned counsel then makes reference to the policies dated 30.12.1998 and 25.02.1999 to support the claim of the petitioners for regularization. Reference is further made to instructions which are appended as Annexures P-2 to P-4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that to sort out their grievance, the petitioners have submitted a legal notice dated 20.03.2020 (Annexure P-11), which has not been decided till date.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the representation dated 20.03.2020 (Annexure P-11), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 20.03.2020 (Annexure P-11), within a period of three months, from the receipt of copy of this order.

The present writ petition stands disposed of.
