Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits, *inter alia*, that the petitioner was already on bail in this case, which was at the trial stage. He, however, could not appear in the Court on one date, i.e. 06.01.2020, as he had to go out of station in connection with his job requirement. In his absence, coercive processes were issued against him, and tracking of the case on the Court's Official Server only showed that from 06.01.2020, when the matter was fixed for prosecution evidence, it was postponed to 31.01.2020 for the same purpose and there was no indication to the effect that his bail bond had been cancelled.
