The petitioners, who are admittedly not married to each other, claim protection of their life and liberty from the hands of respondent no.3 to 7.

Respondent no.3 to 7 are residents of District Meerut, Uttar Pradesh. Petitioner No.1-Ramvati is already married to some one else and she does not claim that she has taken a decree of divorce from her husband.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Iqbal Mohammad, has submitted that both the petitioners are residents of State of Uttar Pradesh and they had resided on the given address only for a period of 15 days only to invoke the jurisdiction of this Court. He further submitted that now the petitioners are not residing at the given address.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the petitioners are relegated to the remedy before the appropriate Court.
