The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 66 dated 13.05.2020 registered under Sections 21, 22 and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Tappa Mandi, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner confines his prayer to grant of interim bail till the receipt of report of the FSL.

Learned State counsel concedes that the FSL report has still not been presented in the Court.

Thus, the petitioner is entitled to grant of interim bail till the FSL report is received.

Accordingly, the petition is partially allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned till the date of receipt of report of the FSL. The petitioner is directed to surrender on the date the FSL report is presented in the Court.
