The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction for the representations dated 11.07.2020 and 17.07.2020 to be decided expeditiously.

It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against private respondent Nos. 4 to 8, who are the main persons involved. Learned counsel for the petitioners urges that the representation should be decided expeditiously.
