On 27.7.2020, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.0044, dated 08.04.2020, registered under Section 324/326/506/148/149 IPC, at Police Station Daresi, District Ludhiana.

In a nutshell, the case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with his co-accused attacked first informant and his brother. The petitioner gave injury on his left arm with 'kirpan'.

Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Learned counsel for the petitioner

contends that there is a delay of 27 days in registration of the FIR as the alleged incident is of 12.03.2020, whereas the FIR was got registered on 08.04.2020. He further submits that the petitioner is attributed to have caused simple injuries to the injured.

Notice of motion for 11.08.2020.

On the request of this court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the order dated 27.7.2020 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
