Prayer in this criminal writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6.

Perusal of the paper book reveals that the present petition has been filed by the petitioners without making any representation to the authorities for the grievances raised by them in the present petition.

Therefore, this Court does not find any reason to interfere so as to invoke the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.
