This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Petitioner is aggrieved of the pensionary/ service benefits of her husband namely Parladh Aggarwal, not being released to the petitioner after her husband's death on 13.04.2018.

It is submitted that representation dated 05.01.2019 and 20.12.2019, attached as Annexures P-3 and P-4, have not been decided by respondent no.2. The petitioner claims to be the duly wedded, second wife of the deceased employee, namely Parladh Aggarwal. Respondent no.4, is the mother of the deceased employee. Respondents no.5 and 6 are the children of the deceased from his first marriage. Grievance set forth, is that the respondent authorities are not deciding the matters expeditiously in accordance with law.

At this stage, it is submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case her representation dated 20.12.2019 (Annexure P-4), is decided by the authorities, in a time bound manner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above as well as the limited prayer addressed, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2-The Chief Administrator, Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran Sector-6, Panchkula, to expeditiously decide representation dated 20.12.2019 (Annexure P-4), after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as to respondents no.4 to 6,in accordance with law, preferably within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Furthermore the retiral benefits as maybe due to the petitioner/claimants, be released to them within the next two weeks thereafter.
