1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that Hon'ble the Division Bench has granted stay of operation of the impugned judgment vide order dated 16.09.2020 in LPA No.1651 of 2019 and that in the circumstances, no further orders are called for in the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such.
3. Faced with the aforementioned position, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the contempt petition at this stage and the same may be disposed of, as such, while granting liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the contempt petition, if the circumstances of the case, so warrant, pursuant to the decision in aforementioned LPA.

4. The same is not opposed by learned counsel for the respondents.
5. Accordingly, in the light of the statement of learned counsel, the contempt petition is ***disposed of*** as not pressed, at this stage, with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the contempt petition, if the circumstances of the case, so warrant, pursuant to the decision in LPA No.1651 of 2019.
