It has been stated by the learned counsel for the petitioners that the marriage of petitioner No.1 was solemnized with respondent No.4 and the petitioner No.2 was born from the wedlock. The matrimonial dispute has cropped up between petitioner No.1 and respondent No.4. Respondents No.5 to 9 are the relatives of respondent No.4. On account of matrimonial dispute, the petitioners are residing separately and they have been given shelter by one Baljeet Singh son of Balvir Dass, resident of Village Badhata, District Barnala. The petitioners are apprehending danger to their lives and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 9. The petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 16.07.2020 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2.
