Petitioner Kuldeep Kaur, who is wife of respondent No.4 Jaswinder Singh, has filed this criminal writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

The representation (Annexure P-2) so attached with the present petition shows that there is matrimonial discord between the petitioner and respondent No.4 for which the petitioner has the appropriate remedy to

invoke. Therefore, this Court does not find any reason to interfere its jurisdiction under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
