The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of the restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Ram Bhul, stated to be aged 39 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer to grant him anticipatory bail in case FIR No.227, dated 07.06.2019 under Sections 323, 452, 427 of IPC, registered at Police Station Rai, District Sonipat.

Vide order dated 28.07.2020, the petitioner was granted interim bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ravinder Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial

interrogation is no more required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 28.07.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.
