The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.07 dated 31.01.2020 under Sections 307, 341, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Fathu Dyinga, District Kapurthala.

Petitioner is author of non-specific injury. He along with others is alleged to have inflicted injuries on the son of the complainant with their weapons on different parts of the body.

According to learned State counsel, one injury is attributed to the petitioner on the head of Narinder Singh which falls under the ambit of Section 324 IPC. The main injury is

attributed to Shankar Singh i.e. kirpan blow on the head of Narinder Singh which hit on the right eye and right side of the forehead.

Co-accused namely Mangal Singh has been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M No.18828 of 2020 vide order dated 04.08.2020.

Petitioner is in custody since 01.06.2020.

Learned State counsel submits that challan has already been presented, but charges have not been framed so far.

Keeping in view the situation arising out of pandemic COVID-19 and without meaning anything on the merits of the case, petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/concerned Duty Magistrate.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.
