The petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking writs in the nature of certiorari as well as mandamus.

During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner has restricted his prayer to the extent that respondents No.1 and 2 be directed to decide the legal notice dated 24.11.2019 (P-25) by passing a speaking order thereon within a reasonable time.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Deepak Manchanda, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State of Haryana and has no objection if any such direction is given to decide the legal notice (P-25).

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to decide the legal notice dated 24.11.2019 (P-25) by passing a speaking order thereon, strictly

in accordance with law but in any case within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the instant writ petition stands disposed of.
