Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.34 dated 28.01.2019 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC registered at Women Police Station, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner and respondent No.2 are staying together as husband and wife. Earlier, they stayed for some time at Churu (Rajasthan), where the parents of the petitioner are staying. However, with the consent of the petitioner, the respondent No.2 is living in Dhanas (Chandigarh) in rented accommodation, but they have no matrimonial dispute.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is allowed and the order dated May 03,

2019 whereby arrest of the petitioner was stayed by this Court, is made absolute.

However, in case the petitioner is required in the case in any manner, a clear 15 days notice shall be served upon him.
