1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.44 dated 19.06.2020, registered under Sections 498-A, 354-A (I), 323, 406, 313 and 34 IPC, at Police Station Women Police Station, District Hisar.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 30.07.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and fully cooperated with the Police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned State Counsel, Haryana on instructions from *HC Kavita*, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 30.07.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
5. In view of the statement of learned State Counsel, Haryana, order dated 30.07.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
6. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
