The present criminal revision is filed against the order denying regular bail to the petitioner even though he is a juvenile. As per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner armed only with a *danda*. No specific injury has been attributed to him. There is nothing on record to show that the petitioner if released is likely to come in contact with criminals. Challan has already been filed.

In view of the above, the criminal revision is allowed and the order denying regular bail to the petitioner is set aside. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board/Duty Magistrate concerned.
