1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.100, dated 08.07.2020, registered under Sections 323, 324, 325 and 34 IPC, besides Section 326 IPC added later on, at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, District Gurdaspur.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 31.07.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and fully cooperated with the Police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that her custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned DAG, Punjab, on instructions from *ASI Sakatar Singh*, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 31.07.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and that her custodial interrogation is not required.
5. In view of the statement of learned DAG, Punjab, order dated 31.07.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
6. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
