It is stated that petitioner No.1 – Umesh Kumar, aged about 25 years has got married with petitioner No.2 - Neeru aged about 27 years against wishes of her relative arrayed as respondent No.4, who is threatening to interfere in their marital life, as such to seek protection in that regard, they have approached this Court by way of filing the present petition.

Of course nobody can be allowed to take law into his hands and to indulge in illegal activities.

behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Heard.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Ludhiana to look into the grievances of the petitioners and to take necessary measures to ensure that lives and liberty of the petitioners are not jeopardized at the hands of respondent No.4 or persons claiming under him.

However, this order shall not validate the marriage between the petitioners and shall not have any effect on any civil or criminal action to which the petitioners may be found liable, under the law.
