With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the matter is being taken up and heard via video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing at length prays for and is permitted to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to file a representation against the rejection of his technical bid.

Learned counsel for the FCI submits that in case the petitioner does so within a week, the representation shall be considered and decided by the respondent-authorities within a period of two weeks thereafter.
