GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of the restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Gurpreet Kaur, stated to be aged 22 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer to grant her anticipatory bail in case FIR No.65, dated 28.06.2020 under Sections 452, 323 of IPC, registered at Police Station Balianwali, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 28.07.2020, the petitioner was granted interim bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajwant Singh states that the petitioner has joined investigation and her custodial interrogation is no more required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated

28.07.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.
