1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Pursuant to the order of this Court dated 29.07.2020, the petitioners had put in appearance before the learned Ilqa Magistrate, Faridkot and were admitted to interim bail.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant states that allegations against the petitioners are serious, therefore, they are not entitled to bail.
4. Per contra, learned Counsel for the petitioners contends that

Magistrate, Faridkot vide order (Annexure P-9) dated 27.02.2020 for 30.07.2020 in a complaint pertaining to the year 2017 under Sections 307 / 148 / 149 / 364 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, in respect of an offence alleged to have been committed in the year 2009 qua which the petitioners were found innocent and the cancellation report submitted by the police was accepted by the learned trial Court. Learned Counsel further contends that co-accused Jaspal Singh, who is the main accused was admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the learned Ilaqa Magistrate pursuant to orders dated 03.06.2020 in CRM-M No.13868 of 2020 and the bail granted to said Jaspal Singh by the learned Ilaqa Magistrate was confirmed by this Court.

5. I have heard learned counsel and in view of the fact that the petitioners were summoned by the learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot vide order (Annexure P-9) dated 27.02.2020 for 30.07.2020 in a complaint pertaining to the year 2017 under Sections 307 / 148 / 149 / 364 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, in respect of an offence alleged to have been committed in the year 2009 qua which the petitioners were found innocent and cancellation report submitted by the police was accepted by the learned trial Court besides co-accused Jaspal Singh, who is the main accused was admitted to bail pursuant to orders dated 03.06.2020 in CRM-M No.13868 of 2020 and the bail granted to said Jaspal Singh by the learned Ilaqa Magistrate was confirmed by this Court, orders of the learned Ilaqa Magistrate, Faridkot admitting the petitioners to interim bail are made absolute.
