Counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the order dated 03.09.2020, the present petition has become infructuous. The said order reads under:-

“In pursuance of the order dated 28.08.2020, Rachpal Singh, DSP, Sub-station Maur, District Bathinda has produced the detenue, Sandeep Kaur, by Video Conferencing.

This Court has interacted with the detenue after ensuring that there is no other person in the room except the said officer. Her father, Boota Singh was also present at the initial stage. From the interaction, it is apparent that the detenue, Sandeep Kaur is willing to go along with the petitioner, however with a condition that he will keep her in a separate place and not in the joint family residence. Mr.Garg submits that the petitioner is willing to do that. This Court has also interacted with the petitioner also by the same mode.

Accordingly, directions are issued to Rachpal Singh, DSP, Substation Maur, District Bathinda that the petitioner shall come forth on 08.09.2020 at 10 AM at his office. He will give an undertaking before the said officer that he would stay in a separate accommodation along with the detainee. The said detainee will also be produced by the said officer and allowed to go with the petitioner, without interference from her family members. It is however made clear that in case the detainee does not wish to stay with the petitioner, it is always open to her to withdraw her consent and come back to her parental home.

To come up on 15.09.2020.”

Court has also interacted with the parties with the help of Sh. Rachpal Singh, DSP, Sub-station Maur, District Bathinda. He has also submitted that the petitioner has given an undertaking by way of affidavit of the he would stay in a separate accommodation alongwith Sandeep Kaur. Sandeep Kaur has also stated that she will be willing to stay with the petitioner at a separate place.

Keeping in view the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
