The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing the impugned order dated 13.2.2020 (Annexure P-16) passed by the Special Judge, CBI, Punjab vide which the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender in case ECIR No. 06 dated 14.8.2013 registered under Sections 3 and 4 of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2002. Later on FIR No. 126 dated 26.7.2013 was registered under Sections 177, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Division No.5, Civil Lines, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the impugned order has been without adhering to the provisions of Section 82 Cr.P.C. He submits that he is willing to surrender before the Special Court CBI,

SAS.,Nagar and he may be protected till his surrender.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material on record.

In view of the submissions made by the learned counsel, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Special Court, CBI, SAS Nagar on 4th August, 2020. On his appearance, before the court concerned, the court shall proceed against him in accordance with law.
