Petitioner – Neeraj Kaur stated to be aged 32 years has filed the present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* with a prayer to direct the respondents to issue her fresh passport by mentioning her correct place of birth in the passport as Jhammat instead of Chamat.

Records of the case show that on 29.07.2020 notice of motion was issued.

Learned counsel for respondent-UOI, submits that he has instructions from the office of respondent No.2 to submit that in fact the petitioner has already been issued the passport.

Since the substantial relief stands granted, no further orders are called for.
