The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.1 to 3 for taking action against respondents No.4 to 6 in terms of FIR No.345 dated 22.12.2017 under Sections 120-B, 363 and 366 IPC registered at Police Station Dabwali Sadar, District Sirsa.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Prem Kumar, submits that in the aforesaid FIR, the police has conducted investigation and prepared an untraced report, which has been presented to the trial Court on 06.09.2018.

In view of the aforesaid development, when the police has prepared an untraced report and presented the same to the Court, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is hereby dismissed.

So far as the prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner be granted liberty to file protest petition in the case is concerned, it is ordered that in case the trial Court has already issued notice to the petitioner in the cancellation report, the same shall be dealt with in accordance with law and no additional mileage shall be given to the petitioner merely because this petition remained pending before this Court.
