The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.78 dated 04.07.2020 registered under Sections 21, 22 of the NDPS Act at police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala.

On 11.08.2020, following order was passed:-

"The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that FIR No.184 dated 12.12.2019 was registered against the petitioner under Sections 307, 353, 379-B, 186, 332, 333, 148, 149, 120-B IPC, Section 22 of the NDPS Act and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Subhanpur. Petitioner was granted bail by the Court of Sessions vide order dated 25.06.2020 despite stiff opposition by the Police. After nine days of bail in the aforesaid case, the petitioner has been implicated

in this case on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused Sandeep Singh.

Learned State counsel submitted that FSL report is still awaited.

For further consideration, adjourned to 29.09.2020.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 16.08.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from Sub Inspector Jaswant Singh submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation in the case.

In view of above, order dated 11.08.2020 is made absolute. However, petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
