The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 159 dated 11.07.2020 under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Division No. 5, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned DAG Punjab for the respondent-State, on instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh, submits that petitioner have joined the

investigation and he is not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that petitioner is no longer required for custodial interrogation and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 31.07.2020 granting interim bail to petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
