The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.154 dated 04.05.2020 registered under Sections 147, 149, 323, 326 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Gurugram.

On 29.07.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

"The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 21.7.2020 passed in CRM-M No.13452 of 2020 granting anticipatory bail to the co-accused, namely, Rohiot @ Romeo. Learned counsel further states that the alleged complicity of the petitioner is at par with the aforesaid co-

accused.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Anant Kataria, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 2.8.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

List again on 8.9.2020."

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ravinder admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 29.07.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when directed to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
