The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.53 dated 17.06.2020 registered under Sections 323, 341, 365, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Behrampur, District Gurdaspur.

On 29.07.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegation against the petitioner is of catching hold of

the complainant and bringing him inside the house, where Vijay Kumar gave 5-6 baseball blows on the head, back, shoulder and chest of the complainant. Rakesh Kumari tied the legs and arms of the complainant with rope and also tied him with the railing of the stairs. Akshay Kumar put a lock on the gate. Coaccused Vijay Kumar, Rakesh Kumari and Akshay Kumar have been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by the High Court.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr.Rana Harjadeep, DAG, unjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 2.8.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

List again on 8.9.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sarwan Singh admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of above, interim order dated 29.07.2020 is

made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
