Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

In response to the notice of motion issued by this Court, photocopy of status report by way of affidavit dated 27.10.2020 of Rajender Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jagadhri (Yamuna Nagar) along with annexures is taken on record. Paras No.4 & 5 of the affidavit read as under:-

“4. That after that on 06.08.2020, ASI Jaswinder Singh visited at the address of the respondent no.4 to 6 and they found present at their address. The said respondents submitted their affidavits in support of their statement and stated that they have no objection with the marriage of Nishu with Buntty s/o Jasmer and they will not interfere in their life. The true

translated copies of the affidavits dt. 06.08.2020 of the respondent no.4 to 6 are enclosed herewith as annexure R-1 to R-3.

5. That thereafter, ASI Jaswinder Singh visited at the address of the petitioners. The petitioners found present at the said address and they got recorded their statements. In their statements, the petitioners stated that they have solemnized marriage as per their wish and will and they had got protection from the Hon'ble High Court. However, now they have no need of any police protection as they have no threat from the private respondents. The true translated copies of statements of the petitioners are enclosed herewith as annexure R-4 and R-5. In view of aforesaid facts and circumstances a cancellation report has also been prepared in aforementioned case FIR No.654 dt. 27.07.2020.”

In view of the stand taken by official respondents No.1 to 3, in paras No.4 & 5, extracted hereinabove, learned counsel for the petitioners states that as on today, nothing survives in the petition.

In view of the above, petition has become infructuous and is disposed off, accordingly.

However, it is clarified that in case the occasion so arises, petitioners would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.
