The prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.95 dated 01.07.2020 under Sections 61/78(2) of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 and later on Section 307 of IPC was added, registered at Police Station Model Town, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

Issue notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Vermani, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State.

It is not disputed that the co-accused have since been granted regular bail, vide order dated 11.08.2020 passed in CRM-M-21029 of 2020. Accordingly, this Court finds no ground to distinguish the case of the present petitioner from that of co-accused.

In view of the same, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing of bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
