The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

By filing this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No. 46 dated 7.3.2020 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana.

Notice of motion was issued to State. Meanwhile, petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail and directed to join investigation.

On instructions from ASI Manjit Singh, learned State counsel submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 2 states that in terms of compromise (Annexure-P-2) entered between parties, sale deed has already been executed. An amount of Rs. 2,00,000/- has been paid to complainant and Rs. 3,00,000/- remain to be paid to complainant.

Learned counsel for petitioner states that as agreed in compromise, the amount of Rs. 3,00,000/- would be paid to complainant at the time of recording of statement of parties in a petition filed for quashing of FIR. He states that petitioner will abide by terms and conditions of compromise. He further states that quashing petition is likely to be filed within one week.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Order dated 29.7.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to petitioner is made absolute. However petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
