1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.180, dated 12.07.2020, registered under Sections 324, 323 and 34 IPC besides Section 326 IPC was added subsequently on 14.07.2020, at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 29.07.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and fully cooperated with the Police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned DAG, Punjab, on instructions from *ASI Jasraj Singh*, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 29.07.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
5. In view of the statement of learned DAG, Punjab, order dated 29.07.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
6. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
